POSITION SUMMARY

This position is responsible for the set-up, installation, maintenance and service of all machinery, shop equipment and infrastructure related to the manufacturing and service of power section components for downhole drilling motors.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Set up and operate machinery and adjusts controls that regulate operational functions to ensure conformance to specifications.
- Start machine and observe mechanical operation to determine efficiency and to detect defects, malfunctions, or other machine damage.
- Establish and perform routine service and preventative maintenance intervals for all machinery.
- Record and maintain production, repair, and machine maintenance information.
- Communicate with or assist other workers to repair or move machines, machine parts or equipment.
- Inspect or test damaged machine parts and marks defective area and advise supervisor of need for repair.
- Coordination of outsourcing work on equipment or machinery.
- Perform minor machining, welding, electrical, mechanical and plumbing maintenance work.
